Florida Law states: "The superintendent must provide the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles the legal name, sex, date of birth, and social security number of each minor who has been reported under this paragraph and who fails to otherwise satisfy the requirements of s. 322.091. The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles may not issue a driver's license or learner's driver's license to and shall suspend any previously issued driver's license or learner's driver's license of, any such minor, pursuant to provisions of s. 322.091." Florida Law states: "If the parent or guardian in charge of the student refuses to participate in the remedial strategies (of the Multi-Tiered Support System Team) because he or she believes that those strategies are unnecessary or inappropriate, the parent or guardian in charge of the student may appeal to the school board. If the board's final determination is that the strategies of the Multi-Tiered Support System Team are appropriate, and the parent or guardian in charge of the student still refuses to participate or cooperate, the superintendent may seek criminal prosecution for noncompliance with compulsory school attendance." Florida Statute 1003.26 (1) (e) Parent/Guardian Initials: _____
The Santa Rosa County School District and the law enforcement agencies of Santa Rosa County operate a Truancy Pick-Up Program during the school year. Officers will stop, interview and take into custody any child believed to be of compulsory school age or currently enrolled in school in Santa Rosa County. Suspended students are also subject to pick-up. Students will be transported to the nearest Truancy Pick-Up Program site for processing.
