ALL ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Self-monitoring is expected of all participants • Symptomatic individuals should stay at home
Academic/Athletics/ Extra-Curricular/ Awards Ceremony or Event	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 100% audience capacity for indoor activities • Social distancing encouraged when feasible • Masks highly recommended • Air purification systems must be present if on campus • Hand sanitizer must be available at entrances
Athletic Signings on campus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 100% audience capacity for indoor activities • Social distancing encouraged when feasible • Masks highly recommended • Air purification systems must be present if on campus • Hand sanitizer must be available at entrances • Athletic signings are limited to varsity team, coaches, immediate family • No food items should be provided at athletic signings • Any special considerations outside the guidelines-contact grade level director
Athletic Travel	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Overnight travel will be allowed • Health screenings required prior to travel • Masks highly recommended while traveling to and from destinations (bus, car, van, etc.) • A prepared written plan must be submitted to Principal no later than a week before the trip that outlines the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Who will stay with a sick student (a name must be provided)? ○ Where will the sick student be monitored? ○ Who will transport a sick student home (if your plan is to have a parent come and pick up a student, that must be included in parent permission paperwork and parents must be clearly informed of this procedure before travel takes place)?
Athletics – During Game	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 100% audience capacity for indoor activities • Social distancing encouraged when feasible • Masks highly recommended • Air purification systems must be present if on campus for indoor activities • Hand sanitizer must be available at entrances • Follow FHSAA recommendations
Athletics – Post Game Considerations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow FHSAA recommendations • No loitering after athletic contests

Athletics – Practice Guidelines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hand sanitizer must be available • Social distancing encouraged when feasible • Players will use their own water bottle/container • No loitering before/after practice • When not actively participating, mask highly recommended • Sanitize sports equipment • Follow FHSAA guidelines
Athletics – Travel Protocol	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masks highly recommended while traveling to and from destinations (bus, car, van, etc.) • Social distancing encouraged when feasible
Band – Indoor Classroom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hand sanitizer must be available • Social distancing encouraged when feasible • Masks highly recommended
Band – Outdoor Performances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Players will use their own water bottle/container • Audience social distancing when feasible
Band – Outdoor Practices	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hand sanitizer must be available • Students will use their own water bottle/container • Social distancing encouraged when feasible • No loitering before/after practice • When not actively participating, mask highly recommended • Sanitize equipment
