ALL ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Self-monitoring is expected of all participants • Symptomatic individuals should stay at home
Academic/Athletics/ Extra-Curricular/ Awards Ceremony or Event	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 50% audience capacity for indoor activities • Social distancing required • Masks highly recommended • Air purification systems must be present if on campus • Sanitizer must be available at entrances
Athletic Signings on campus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 50% audience capacity for indoors • Social distancing required • Masks highly recommended • Air purification systems must be present if on campus • Sanitizer must be available at entrances • Athletic signings are limited to varsity team, coaches, immediate family • No food items should be provided at athletic signings • Any special considerations outside the guidelines-contact grade level director
Athletic Travel	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Overnight travel will be allowed • Masks highly recommended while traveling to and from destinations (bus, car, van, etc.) • No more than 2 student to a room, no sharing of beds, and students should maintain social distancing protocols while in the room • A prepared written plan must be submitted to Principal no later than a week before the trip that outlines the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Who will stay with a sick student (a name must be provided)? ○ Where will the sick student be monitored? ○ Who will transport a sick student home (if your plan is to have a parent come and pick up a student, that must be included in parent permission paperwork and parents must be clearly informed of this procedure before travel takes place)?

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Athletics – Practice Guidelines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Players must have health check performed upon arrival if not on campus throughout day • Small groups – when feasible • Hand sanitizer available • Players will use their own water bottle/container • Players will report with equipment on or retrieve equipment from the locker room (pending local health board and district protocol) • Players will enter designated areas maintaining social distancing prior to the start of practice • Social distancing required • No loitering before/after practice • When not actively participating, mask highly recommended • Sanitize sports equipment • Follow FHSAA guidelines
Athletics – Travel Protocol	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masks highly recommended while traveling to and from destinations • Social distancing required
Band – Indoor Classroom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masks highly recommended • Social distancing as feasible
Band – Outdoor Performances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Resume normal operations
Band – Outdoor Practices	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Resume normal operations
Band – Travel	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Overnight travel will be allowed • Masks highly recommended while traveling to and from destinations (bus, car, van, etc) • No more than 2 student to a room, no sharing of beds, and students should maintain social distancing protocols while in the room • A prepared written plan must be submitted to Principal no later than a week before the trip that outlines the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Who will stay with a sick student (a name must be provided)? ○ Where will the sick student be monitored? • Who will transport a sick student home (if your plan is to have a parent come and pick up a student, that must be included in parent permission paperwork and parents must be clearly informed of this procedure before travel takes place)?

Banquets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No banquets at this time
Bloodmobile	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Allowed at Principal’s discretion
Booster Club Meetings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Outside of school operating hours • 50% capacity for indoor activities • Social distancing required • Masks highly recommended
Chorus – Indoor Classroom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masks highly recommended • Social distancing required

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Chorus – Indoor Performances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 50% audience capacity for indoor activities • Social distancing required • Masks highly recommended • Air purification systems must be present if on campus • Sanitizer must be available at entrances
Chorus – Outdoor Performances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Audience social distancing where feasible • Social distancing for performers • No masks required when singing
Class Meetings (example – senior class meetings)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 50% audience capacity for indoor activities • Social distancing required • Masks highly recommended
College Recruiting activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 50% audience capacity for indoor activities • Social distancing required • Masks highly recommended • Sanitizer must be available at entrances • Administrator supervision to monitor audience social distancing
Community Parades	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Limit participants on floats and cars • Social distancing required • Masks highly recommended
Concession Stands	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All food must be prepared and served using public health guidelines • Prepackaged food encouraged whenever possible • Social distancing required and PPE must be worn by volunteers
Elementary Music	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social distancing where feasible • Masks not required for indoor singing (revision to original guidelines)
Elementary Music – Indoor Performances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 50% audience capacity for indoor activities • Social distancing required • Masks highly recommended • Air purification systems must be present if on campus • Sanitizer must be available at entrances
Elementary Music – Outdoor Performances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Audience social distancing where feasible • Social distancing for performers • No masks required when singing
Field Trips	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No additional field trip requests are being accepted at this time • Consideration will be given for field trips during the 2nd nine weeks
Indoor Plays/Drama	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 50% audience capacity for indoor activities • Social distancing required • Masks highly recommended • Air purification systems must be present if on campus • Sanitizer must be available at entrances
Military Recruiters on campus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continue social distancing protocols
Locker Room Protocol	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continue social distancing protocols • Ensure cleaning before and after use
Pep Rallies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Outdoors only

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Pre-event Meals for students	<p>On Campus:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Location must be large enough for social distancing protocols • Air purifier must be present • All food must be prepared and served using public health guidelines • Prepackaged food encouraged whenever possible • PPE must be worn by servers <p>Off Campus:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Venue must be large enough for social distancing protocols • Buffet-type serving must not be self-serve • Outdoor venues preferred
Requests for Facility Usage by Outside Agencies (Indoor and Outdoor)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No additional facilities use agreements being accepted at this time
Required PD - out of District	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Requires Superintendent or designee approval
ROTC Qualifying Events Approval	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Requires Grade Level Director approval
SAC, PTO, IEP, 504, Parent Conferences Meetings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 50% audience capacity for indoor activities • Social distancing required • Masks highly recommended
School-Based After School Clubs/Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 50% audience capacity for indoors • Social distancing required • Masks highly recommended • Sanitizer must be available at entrances
Student volunteers between secondary and elementary schools	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Suspended at this time
Tournaments	Detailed itinerary and proper school board forms must be submitted to grade level director for approval
TSIC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social distancing required • Masks highly recommended
Visitors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visitors should be allowed on campus only for essential business • Parents attending school lunch is suspended at this time • Individuals should screen for symptoms prior to school arrival • Social distancing required • Masks highly recommended
Volunteer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Essential volunteers only at the Principal's discretion • Individuals should screen for symptoms prior to school arrival • Social distancing required • Masks highly recommended
