- ✓ Cell phone policy- includes taking/bringing pictures/videos on campus through electronic devices (pg. 35,43)
- ✓ Dress Code (.pg. 18)
- ✓ Search and seizure (pg. 23)
- ✓ Electronic devices and other valuables -please keep in mind that YOU and YOUR CHILD takes the risk of a device being stolen or broken if brought from home. (pg. 21)
- ✓ Defiance and Classroom disruptions (pg. 34)
- ✓ Bullying- October is Anti-bullying month, there will be activities to raise awareness of what bullying is and is not and ways to combat the issue of bullying. The Dean of Students will be visiting all classes to discuss bullying. (pg. 32)
- ✓ Bus transportation—For safety of all students and the driver, these rules and guidelines must be followed. Failure to follow procedures could result in loss of privilege of riding the bus. (pg. 22)
