▪ **Principal's report [D. Brock]**

◆ **FSA Testing**

- Teachers are using the district assessment data to identify students strengths and weaknesses to prepare the students to be successful on the FSA. Testing will start the first week in May.
- The State is coming to observe the FSA process at the school. They will come the first week of May, possibly on May 3rd. They randomly select a middle, high, and elementary school to observe over each county across the state of FL. KMS was randomly picked at a site.
- This is the last year of state testing is half true. The state has not decided what program will replace the state testing, but there will still be state testing for the EOC exams just not the Math and Reading/Writing state tests. The state will cut down to 3 assessments a school year and shorten the tests to 25-30 questions.

◆ **After school tutoring**

- After school tutoring is offered Monday through Thursday for students to get help with homework and continue to practice their academic skills.

- On Wednesday's in April there is Algebra 1 tutoring for students taking the Algebra 1 EOC.
