SCHOOL ADVISORY COUNCIL MINUTES
May 14, 2019

Attendance:

Call to Order:

A meeting of the King Middle School Advisory Council was held in the King Middle School Media Center on May 14, 2019. Robert Cole called the meeting to order at 7:38am. Meredith McKnight will record minutes for this meeting.

Minutes:

Jessica Frater motioned to approve the minutes of April 8, 2019, with no corrections needing to be made. Ronald Wires, Jr. 2nd the motion. Motion approved unanimously.

Old Business:

SAC Workday: Workday was rescheduled until May 18th. Mr. Cole has taken pictures of projects that need to be completed around the campus. Some teachers are offering extra credit to students that participate.

Volleyball Courts: Poles for the nets are going in the ground on Thursday, May 16th. We will need to purchase landscape timbers and stakes to outline a perimeter of the court. Discussion was held on how much money will be spent on the purchase of these items. Kathryn Stephens motioned that up to \$500 to be spent on material. Julie Blevins 2nd the motion. Motion approved unanimously.

New Business:

School-Parent Compact Agreement: Mrs. Spice spoke to the council regarding the School-Parent Compact Agreement. As council reviewed the agreement, Mrs. Spice opened the floor for discussion regarding the points listed below:

Parent Compact Development: The committee reviewed and discussed each point on the compact and made suggestions. Suggestions are as followed for each point:

1. Discussion held with no changes.
2. Parent/teacher conferences could take place in the afternoons if teachers would be compensated or maybe there could be some other

form of communication between the parent and teacher as in a Skype conference or a teacher website where parents are able to go and see what the student's homework is for the night.

3. Videotaping classes, virtual tour of the school or purchasing products for parents to see what the student's homework is.
4. Phones in every class.
5. Parent Nights call outs for special opportunities for parents.

Annual School Report Card: Mrs. Blevins inquired as to where to find the school grade and Mr. Cole showed us on the FDOE website.

Parent Involvement: Ms. Spice informed the committee that she is responsible for keeping a parent involvement log for the year and that parent involvement activities are funded through Title 1 funds. Mr. Brock explained that each year funds are set aside from Title 1 budget for Parent Improvement and that each year, the school spends approximately \$8,000-\$10,000 on family nights. Mrs. Spice informed the committee of the family night activities for the current 2018-2019 school year: Open house for all grades, Holiday Fest, Bookfair, Chorus concert, and King Kon. Ms. Spice opened the floor for discussion as to any ideas for future Family Nights. Kelly Lee suggested more and bigger events. Julie Blevins suggested maybe an obstacle course or a trivia night. Mr. Brock mentioned a Genius Bowl/Brain Bowl. Amy Gambrell stated Jeopardy or another night like The Trial of Dorothy Gail. Jackson Gambrell suggested doing another Escape Room Night which was very popular 2 years ago. The school has a link and QR Code on the school website which the parents can access and do surveys regarding Family Nights. PTO will post the link to their Facebook page.

New SAC positions open for next year: The committee was notified of three (3) vacant positions for next year, President, Vice President and Secretary. Julie Blevins was supposed to move into the President spot, but Julie is relocating out of the state and will be unable to fulfill this position. Darren Brock motioned that Kathryn Stephens be appointed President. Ronald Wires, Jr. 2nd the motion. Discussion was held with motion passing unanimously.

Vice President position will be vacant due to the two-year term to serve. Julie Blevins motioned that Robert Cole be appointed Vice President. Ronald Wires, Jr. 2nd the motion. Discussion was held with motion passing unanimously.

Secretary position will be vacant due to Meredith McKnight no longer working at King Middle. Gail Lowe motioned that Amy Gambrell be appointed Secretary. Julie Blevins 2nd motion. Discussion was held with motion passing unanimously.

PTO Report: PTO report was provided by Jessica Frater. They have one remaining fundraiser at Texas Roadhouse this school year. Teacher Appreciation

Breakfast went very well. PTO has started a Facebook page and would like for the committee members to join and help spread the word.

Mr. Brock spoke to the committee regarding the 2019-20 School Budget and each member received a handout showing the disbursement of said funds. The committee reviewed the budget. Kelly Lee made a motion to approve the school budget. Ronald Wires, Jr. 2nd the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
