Call to Order:

A meeting of the King Middle School Advisory Council was held in the King Middle School Media Center on February 12, 2019. Robert Cole called the meeting to order at 7:35 am. Meredith McKnight will record minutes for this meeting.

Minutes:

Julie Blevins motioned to approve the minutes of December 11, 2018, with no corrections needing to be made. Ronnie Wires, Jr. 2nd the motion. Motion approved unanimously.

Old Business:

No old business needed to be discussed.

New Business:

Rate for Tutoring: SAC approved to increase the rate of hourly pay for teachers for after-school tutoring to \$30 per hour. The current rate of pay per Master Contract is \$20 per hour. Christina Carpenter 2nd the motion. Motion approved unanimously.

Bike Rack: Ms. Carpenter suggested that the committee install a cover over the existing bike rack. Mr. Cole would like to table the idea to make sure that the committee is able to approve such an expenditure.

Reports:

PTO Report: PTO report was provided by Jessica Frater. They have started selling Valentine Grams and continue to sale them until Thursday.

Principal's Report: Mr. Brock addressed the committee regarding the new color-coded maps that are hanging throughout the school. Every hallway in the school is labeled with a color to identify hallways in an emergency. The topic of Common Core came up and Mr. Brock addressed that Governor DeSantis has done away with this standard. He mentioned that nothing immediate would happen and that it would take several years for this to be implemented. Another topic discussed, practice writing test that the entire school will take this week. This test is supposed to help identify and address problems.

Treasurer's Report: The committee has \$3,978.11 in the account currently.

Student's Report: King Middle Academic Team competed in MathCounts this past weekend. We had one (1) student place in the top five (5) and will be able to participate in the state competition.
