- 24 credits are needed to graduate
 - 4 credits of English
 - 3 credits of Science (including 1 credit in Biology)
 - 4 credits of math (including 1 credit in Algebra 1 and 1 credit in Geometry)
 - 3 credits of Social Studies (including 1 credit in World History, 1 credit in US History, .5 credit in Economics, .5 credit in Government)
 - 1 Practical or Performing Fine Art
 - 1 PE credit (Personal Fitness .5/ Fitness Lifestyle Design .5)
 - 8 elective credits (including 1 online course)

Total = 24 credits

For information on the Early Graduation (18-credit) Plan, please contact your child's Guidance Counselor.

- All students must have 2.0 GPA to earn a diploma.
- All general education students must pass the FSA Reading & Writing Test *and* the Algebra 1 EOC Test in order to earn a diploma.
- All students must take the following EOC Tests in order to earn credit in the class:
 - *Biology *Algebra I *Geometry *Algebra II *US History(Out-of-state transfer students are encouraged to contact their Guidance Counselor for *possible* exemptions.)
(Please know it is possible to not pass the EOC, yet earn a passing semester exam grade on the Report Card at the end of Second Semester. EOC grades are assigned by the District, while Pass vs. Fail is determined by the State.)
- A student's report card during the school year may not display accurate credits or GPA for classes that are tied to an EOC. This is because we are not able to award credit until the EOC scores are available.
- If your child received a state score report depicting his/her performance on a standardized test, please visit <http://www.fldoe.org/accountability/assessments/fsa-report.stml> for additional clarity and interpretation.
- All parents are highly encouraged to periodically check their child's graduation credits and grades by logging into ClassLink at <https://students.santarosa.k12.fl.us/Account/LogOn> to view the student/parent portal. Grades are updated by teachers every other week.
- All students and parents are also encouraged to regularly check the NHS website, Twitter feed, Facebook, and outdoor marquee for important announcements and reminders.
