

CHAPTER 2.00 - SCHOOL BOARD GOVERNANCE AND ORGANIZATION

LEGAL COUNSEL – SUPERINTENDENT

2.41

- (1) The Superintendent shall have the authority to obtain, at Board expense, an attorney to represent him or her in any legal matter regarding the performance of his or her duties when special counsel is needed beyond the service normally rendered by the School Board attorney.
- (2) This service will be provided only upon the determination that the Superintendent was at the assigned place of duty and was not guilty of willful neglect of duty, gross negligence, or improper conduct.
