

CHAPTER 3.00 - SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

EMERGENCIES

3.23

- (1) In case of an emergency involving the welfare and safety of students and employees, the Superintendent may suspend any part of these regulations, provided that he or she shall report the fact of and the reason for suspension at the next meeting of the School Board and that the suspension shall expire at the time of such report unless continued in effect by actions of the School Board.
- (2) In case of an emergency, the Superintendent may close any school or all schools. The members of the School Board shall be informed immediately of any event or condition which requires the closing of any school(s) of the District.
- (3) In the event of a declared state of emergency, control of pupils shall be retained by school personnel until the pupils are released from school or in the case of transported pupils, until the students depart from the school bus.
- (4) The principal shall cooperate with emergency management and Red Cross authorities in the event of a natural or man-made disaster. In the event of a riot or similar condition, the principal shall cooperate with law enforcement.
- (5) In any case or condition not covered by these regulations, the Superintendent shall base the decision on his or her best judgment.
