

CHAPTER 3.00 - SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

VISITOR IDENTIFICATION MEASURE

3.701+

- I. The Superintendent or designee shall develop a plan for visible identification of visitors or other persons who are not students or employees of the school and shall periodically provide the School Board with the details of this plan. In developing and implementing the plan, the Superintendent shall consider the organization and grade level of the school and input from the principals as to the feasibility of implementing such safety measures.
- II. The Superintendent/designee shall develop guidelines to allow persons convicted of certain crimes as defined in § 856.022, F.S., to visit a school campus or event under specific circumstances. The individual must request approval prior to the activity. If approved to be on campus or at a school event, the individual shall be under the supervision of a designated staff member at all times.
