The SAFE Program is a means for allowing better communication between Santa Rosa County Emergency Responders and residents with special needs, or other disabilities, regarding critical information before an emergency occurs.

For Your Home

First Responders coming to a home will identify the need for special care or communications. Place one decal near your front door.



For Your Car

First Responders on a traffic stop, accident or medical emergency will be able to identify the need for special care or communication. Place one decal on the rear drivers' side of your vehicle.



Sheriff-Police-Fire-EMS

This program is known by all Santa Rosa County First Responders. This is the decal first responders will be looking for.
