


Accessing Student Grades



ADDITIONAL WAY

Your child can share their grades with you by accessing the Focus Portal through their ClassLink account. Your student will use their student ID number (57XXXXXXX) and the password they use to login. The Focus icon they will select in ClassLink looks like this:
