

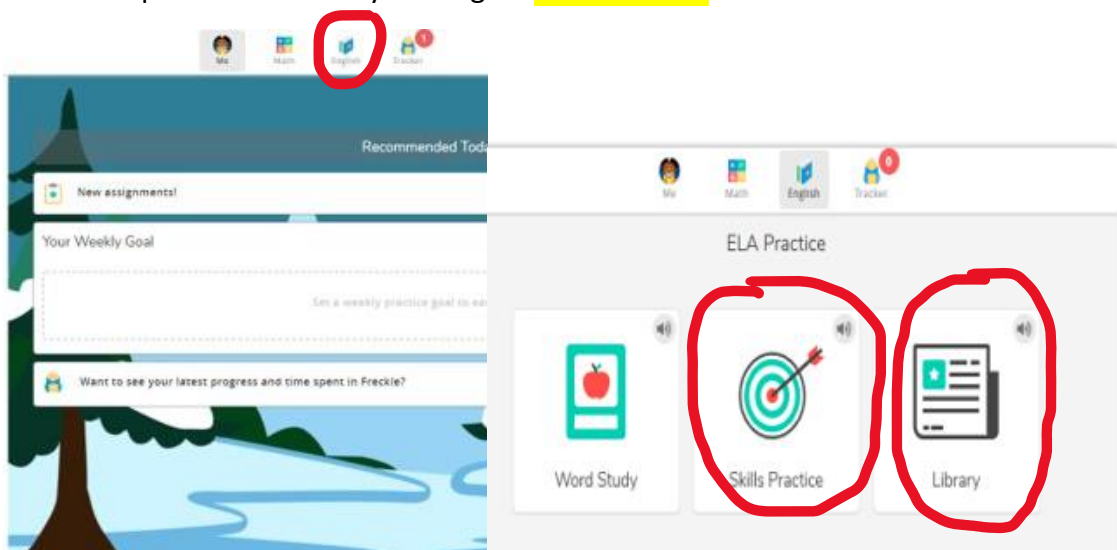
Home Support with Reading Ideas/Tips
