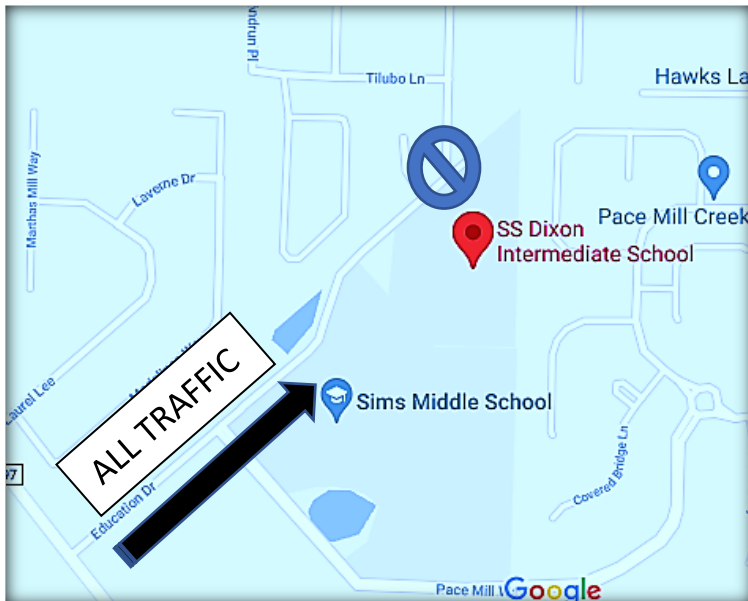
I am happy to report Sheriff Woody had his hat returned! So glad I was able to find Sheriff Woody's kid and get his hat back to him. I know they were happy too!
