Show Dates **Saturday, March 28, 9:00 – 5:00 and Sunday, March 29, 10:00 – 4:00**

This year's GBCA Student Art Show is at the GBHS Fine Arts building during the same time as the professional show. Please tell parents about the student show, its location, and times.

Set Up **Hang your work between 4:00 – 5:00, Friday, Mar 27**

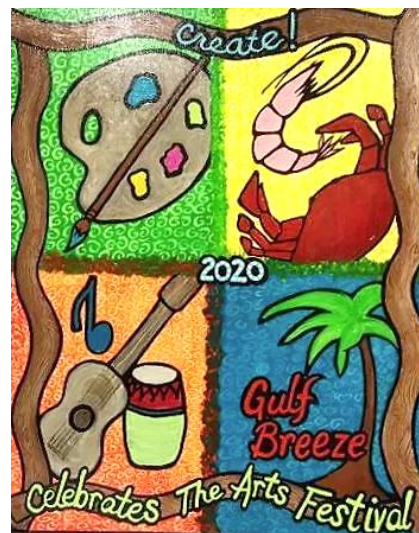
Hang your work 4:00 – 5:00 Friday, March 27. Do not come before 4:00. Park on the bus ramp or by the tennis courts.

My students and I will be happy to set up your work and take it down for you, but you must get it to me at the art building between 4:00 – 5:00 Monday, March 23- no later please. Elementary and middle school work must already be attached to 4' x 4' pieces of roll paper, and 3D pieces must be loosely packed, not taped, in boxes.

Take Down **Sunday, March 29, 4:00 to 4:30**

Please do not remove the art before 4:00. There will be kids there to help you but they also have to clean up, re-set the rooms, and store the boards by 5:00. Don't forget your ribbons!

Or, my students will take down your work and store it in the art building work room until you get it between 4:00 – 5:00, Monday, March 30... or we can work something out. 😊



Elementary Schools **GBHS Art Building Room 532**

Each school gets three (3) 4' x 4' boards set up in a row. It might be easier on you if you have the work attached to 4' x 4' roll paper before you come to make hanging and take-down quicker for you. Work may not extend past the sides; it can hang below up to 6 inches, but at the top it can't be more than 2" above the 4' x 4' boards due to humidity. Please have a label with the student's name on the front of the work and have a sturdy school sign. Tables will be set up for your 3D work. Participation ribbons, scissors and a staple gun will be on the desk in room 532. Cut the number of ribbons you need from the roll on the desk and take them with you Friday. Participation ribbons are not hung.

Middle Schools **GBHS Art Building room 521**

Each school gets three (3) 4' x 4' boards set up in a row. It might be easier on you if you have the work attached to 4' x 4' roll paper before you come to make hanging and take-down quicker. Work may not extend past the sides; it can hang below up to 6 inches, but at the top it can't be more than 2" above the 4' x 4' boards due to humidity. Please have a label with the student's name on the front of the work and have a sturdy school sign. Tables will be set up for 3D work. First, Second, Third, and Honorable Mention ribbons will be hung Saturday morning. Participation ribbons, scissors and a staple gun will be on the table in the room. Cut the number of ribbons you need from the roll on the desk and take them with you Friday. Participation ribbons are not hung.

Judging

Friday, March 27

Only high school and middle school art is judged. Elementary students get participation ribbons. The building will be closed to the public and to middle and high school teachers and all students at 3:30, March 27. Ribbons will be hung by Saturday morning. The judges will not consider directly copied images or logos with only a medium or interpretation change. The student may be inspired by someone else's art or design by making significant changes to it, but they may not copy it exactly. The judges may move a piece to the appropriate category if they feel it's mislabeled.

Directions

GBHS Art Building

The art building is on the west side by the soccer practice field and the bus ramp. To get to the GBHS art building, take Hwy 98 to Gulf Breeze. Turn south at Daniel Drive. Turn right at the next light. Go straight all the way following the road as it makes a sharp right turn just past the tennis courts. The art building is the building on your right after the sharp right turn. Parallel park along this road or park by the tennis courts.
