ATTENDANCE: Anderson, Brown, Butts, Davis, Hull, Price, Robbins, Scheiwe, Stubbs

Meeting called to order at 7:37 am

MINUTES: Minutes approved for January 2019: Davis motion, Brown second, passed unanimously. No discussion.

BUDGET: Budget Report was given to all members. Balance is increased to \$8613.16 due to the FTE in October 2018. This occurs twice a year. Money from the state per child in attendance one week in October and February each year.

SAC BYLAWS: Mr. Price provided a draft mark-up copy of updated Bylaws to be reviewed and approved. Only two additional changes were made (see attached) and approved. Anderson motion, Davis second, passed unanimously.

TITLE I: The Reading Under the Stars parent involvement event went well with about half of the school in attendance. Dinner sold about 200 meals and adult meals may be considered for next year. Mr. Price mentioned that most activities have focused on family/community involvement and not so much on teaching/training parents and the resource booths at RUS did not have much traffic. He asked for suggestions on how to make this sensitive subject appealing to parents. Hull imparted that presentation is important in how it's presented to make it interesting and non-confrontational for parents. Robbins suggested to use a video and/or virtual outreach. Perhaps one per quarter.

Tonight (2/12/19) is the Family Engagement Expo in Pace.

SAFETY CHANGES: The new Safety Role for the district is Daniel Hahn and he is focused on making each school safe. The district has recommended that the gates to WNPS at Sandstone Dr. and Lowe Rd. be closed to prevent access to the school that is unmonitored. The details of this for buses and latch key access and who assists with that is being fine tuned by staff. The front door also has a new push button system that requires ID verification by front office as the front doors are now locked.

OTHER:

- Mr. Price mentioned that they are keeping track of teachers who are “Out of Field” i.e. ESOL students in a class with an ESOL teachers.
- The “Elkhart School” has had Phase 2 approved and the district will get bids in June. It will be a “bare bones” building that can be improved/added on to over time and this is due to state funding.
- The Governor has issued a press release saying that FL will be moving away from standards that are highly aligned to Common Core. This is a long process that will take years before any implementation is seen in the classroom.
- The second school day missed by Hurricane Michael in October 2018 will not need to be made up so March 25th remains a day off.
